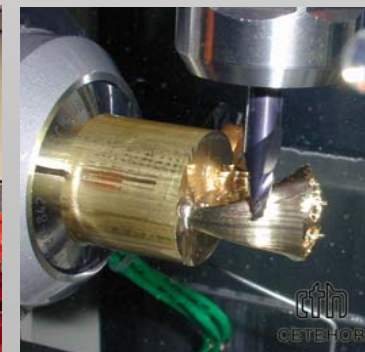
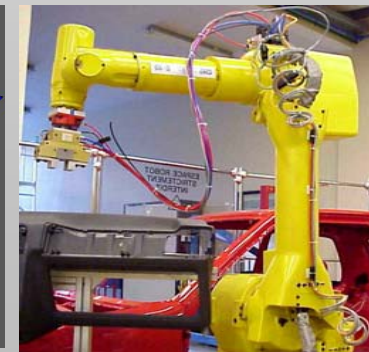
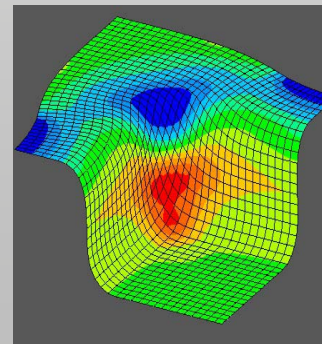
#### Aims of CIRP

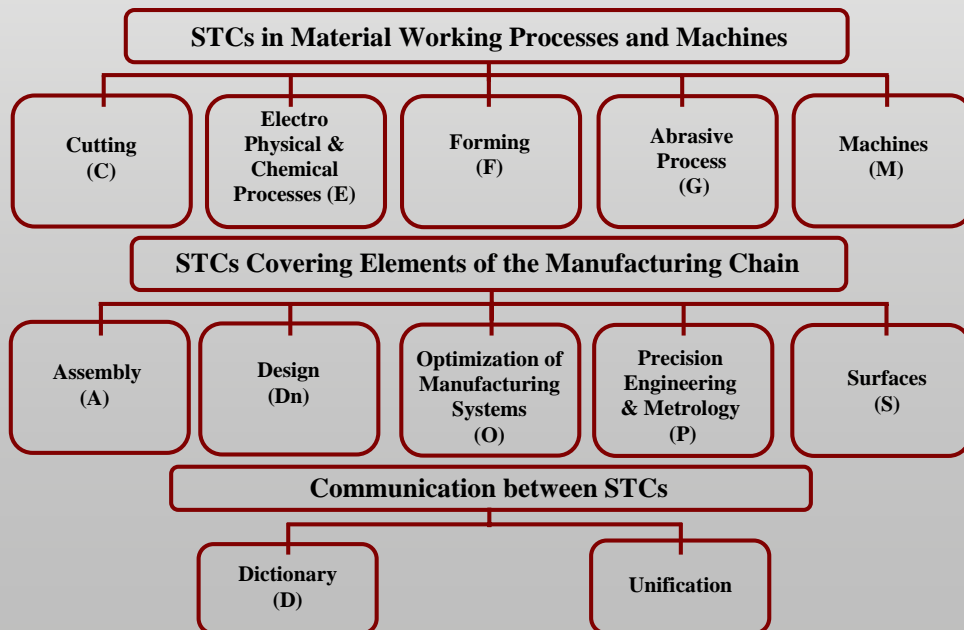


The abbreviation CIRP originates from our French name "Collège International pour la Recherche en Productique"

## CIRP Scientific Technical Committees

Eleven Scientific and Technical Committees (STCs) that are responsible for their subject areas of interest and for coordinating CIRP run collaborative research projects.

Additionally, working groups are created to investigate the special problems of education and training associated with new manufacturing technology.



## CIRP Activities

### Meetings

Twice yearly in January and at the General Assembly in August, open to CIRP members and Corporate members. Non-members may be invited as guests. In the first part (paper sessions) of the General Assembly around 140 authors, from many of the leading manufacturing research institutes worldwide, make presentations dealing with the different aspects of the manufacturing engineering. In the second part of the GA, meetings are held by the various STCs to discuss related CIRP cooperative projects and other technical matters.
